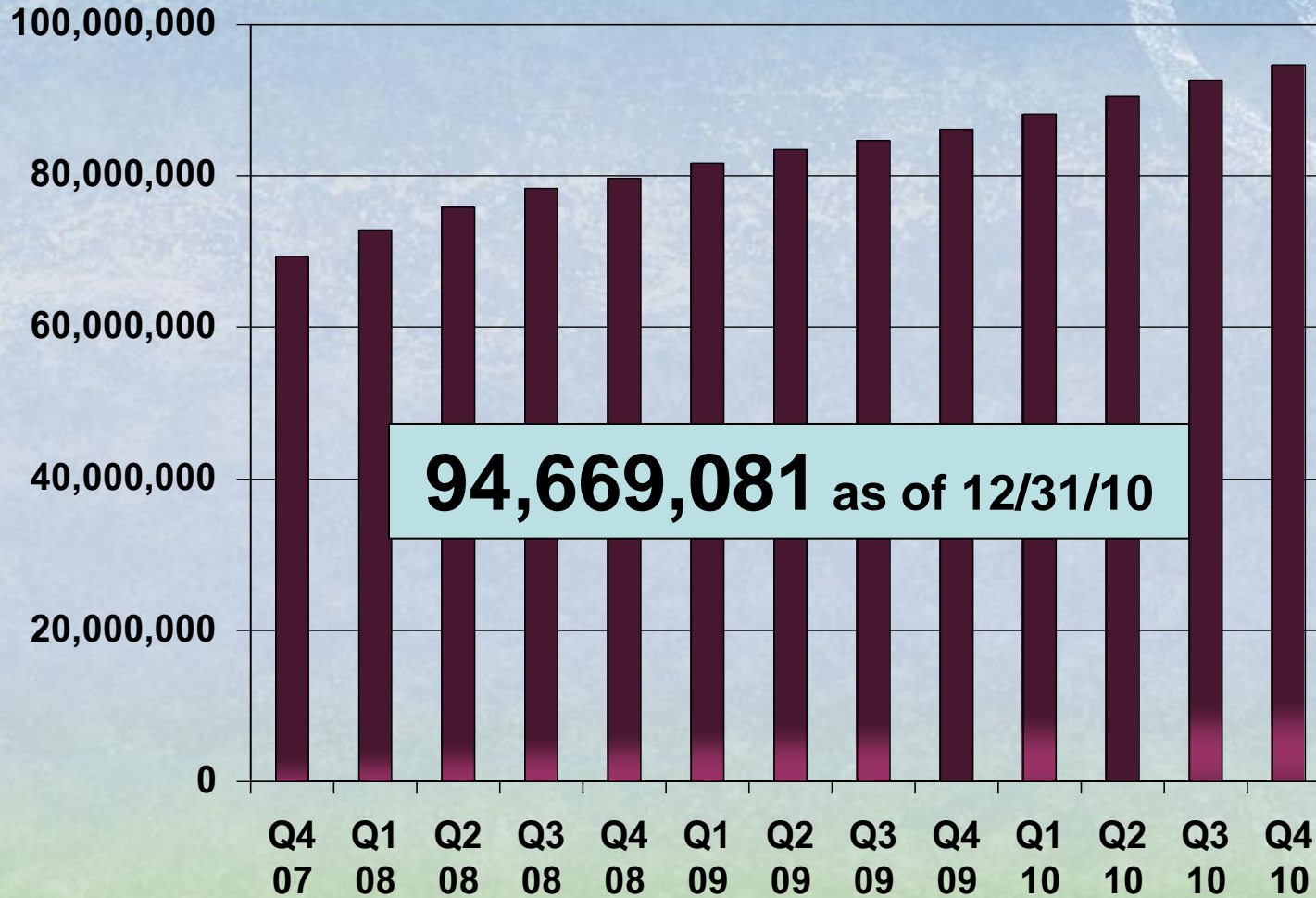

Highlights – Q4 2010

- From Q3 2010 to Q4 2010, the number of designated donors increased 2.1% (9.7% year over year) to 94.7 million, or 40.3% of the U.S. population age 18 and over
- Nationwide, 35.8% (33.2% in the last 12 months) of recovered organ donors, 39.4% (37.3%) of recovered tissue donors, and 44.8% (42.2%) of recovered eye donors were authorized by state donor registries
- Donor designation rate increased from 2009 to 2010 in 18 of 24 states reporting

Summary: Donor Designations, Q4 2010

- There are 94,669,081 designated donors nationwide
- 20 states have signed up more than 2 million designated donors
- 31 states have signed up more than 1 million designated donors
- The number of donor designations increased 9.7% over the last 12 months

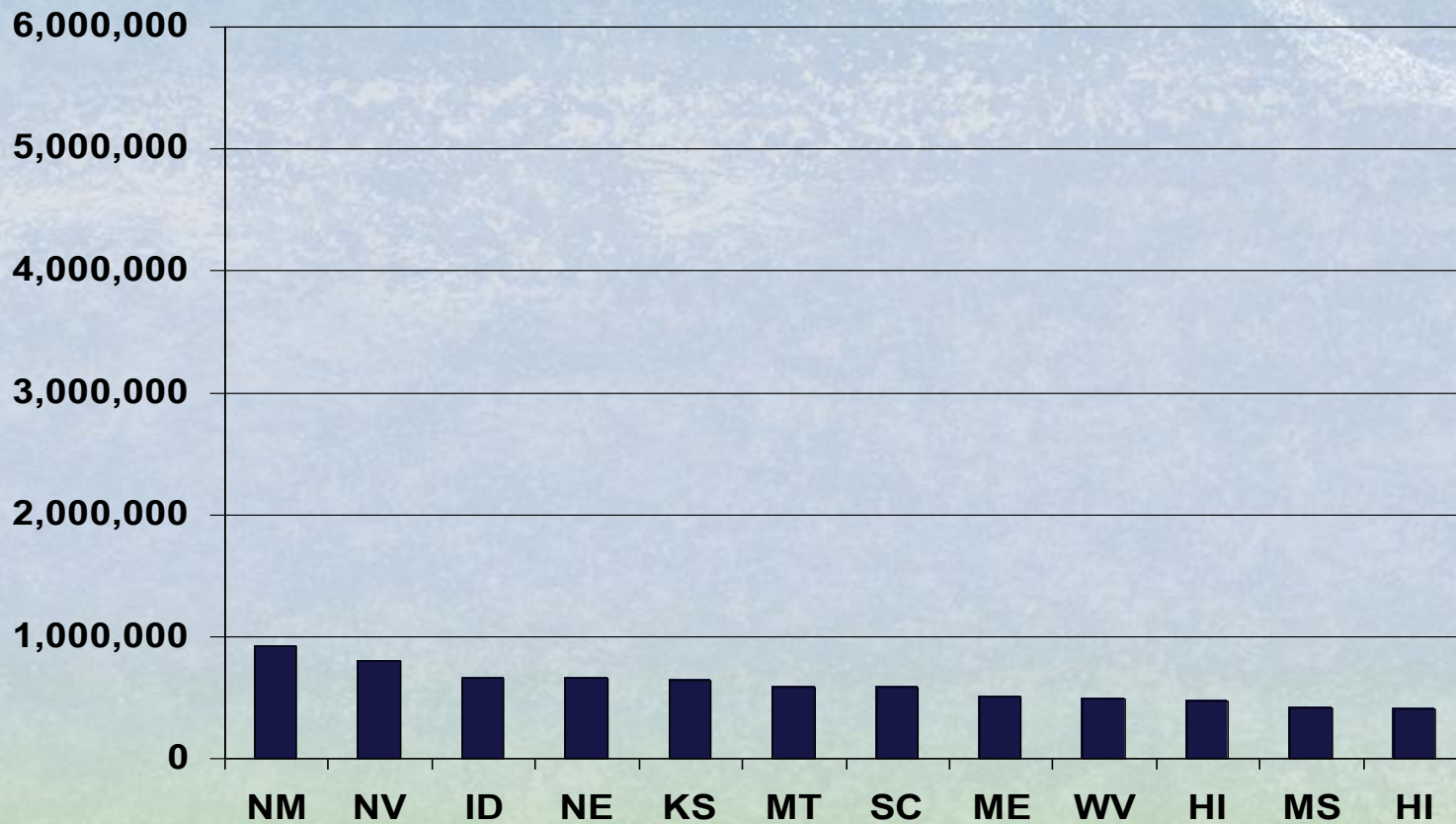
Total Donor Designations, as of 12/31/10



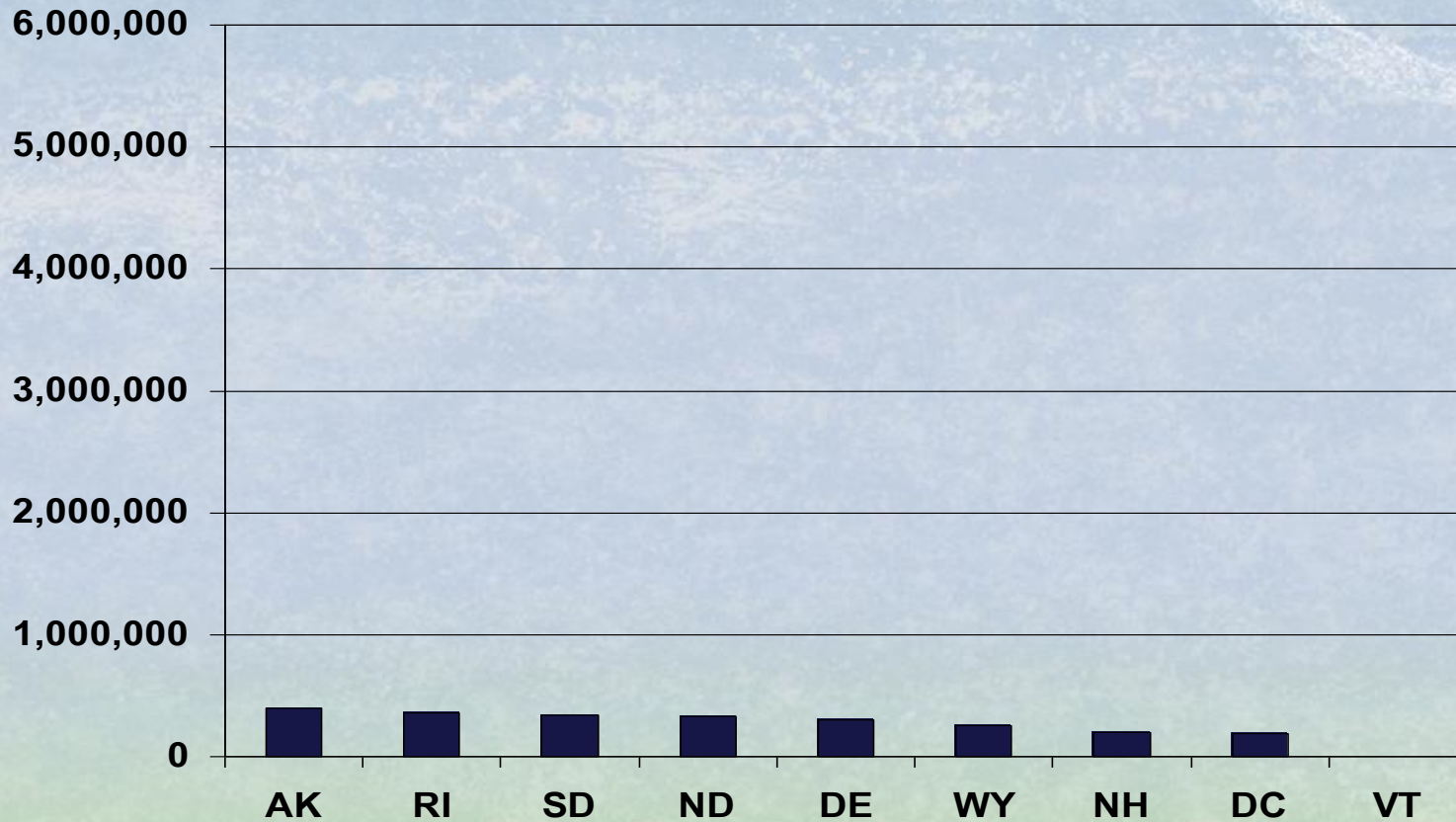

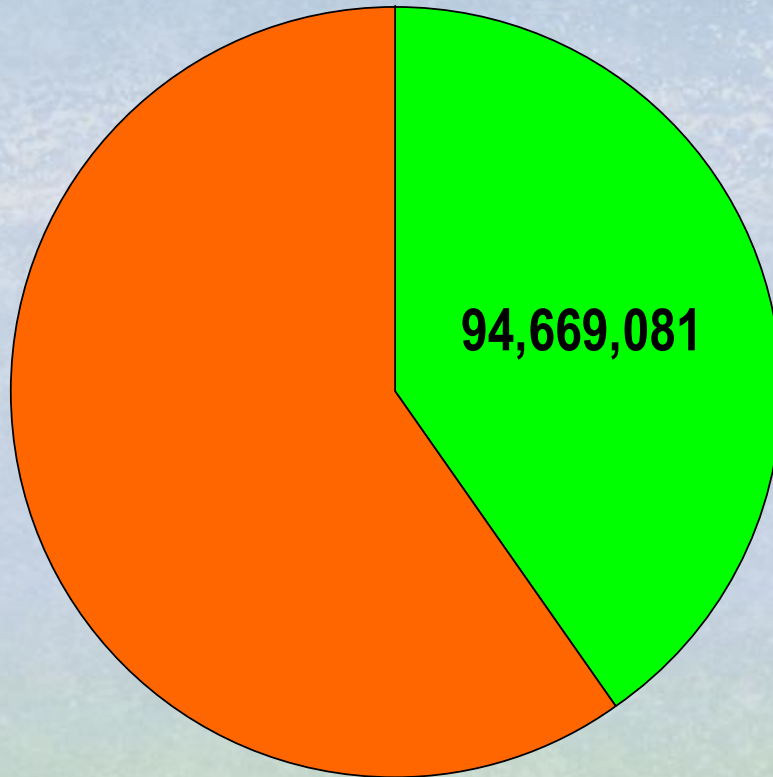

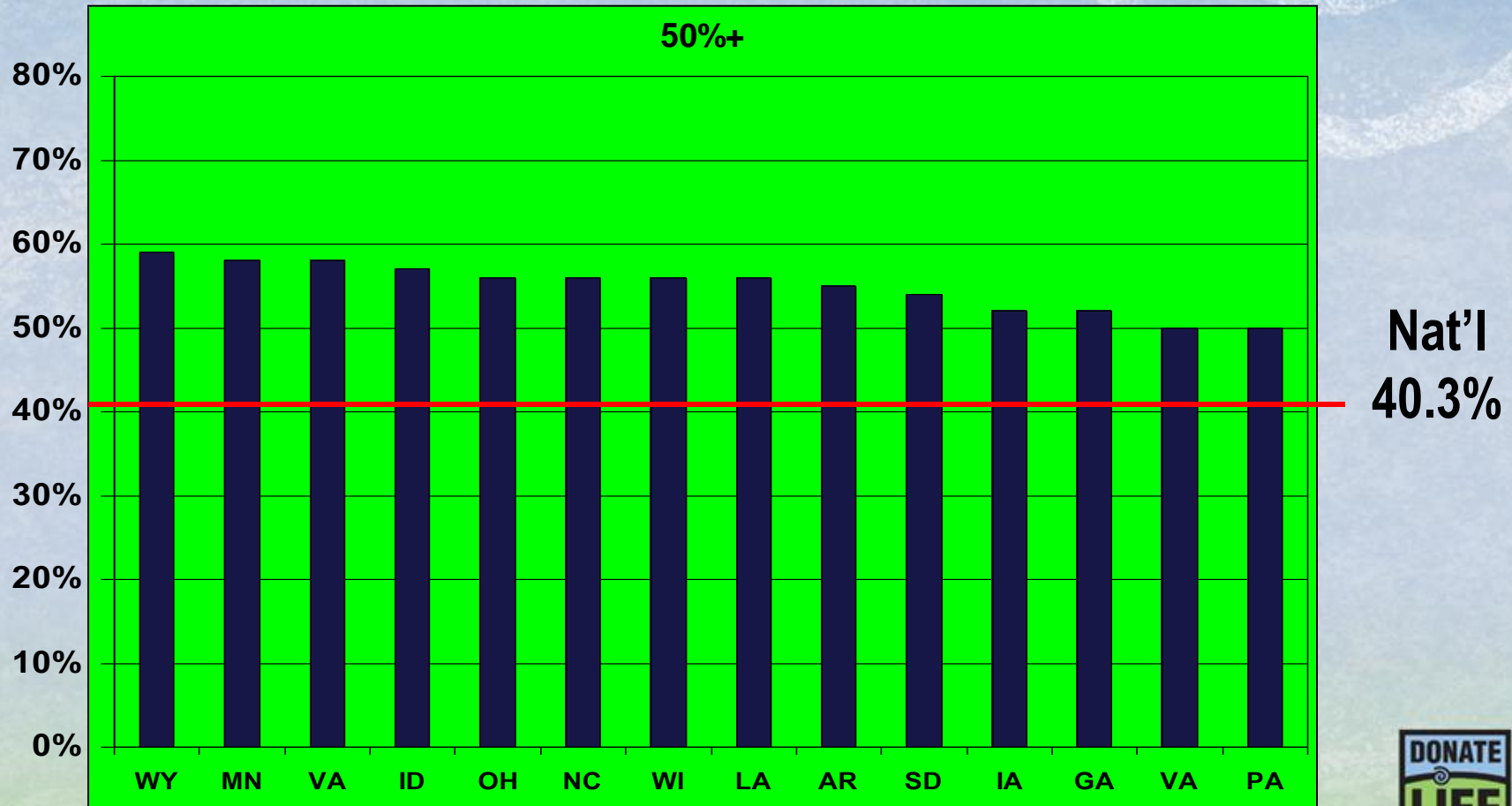

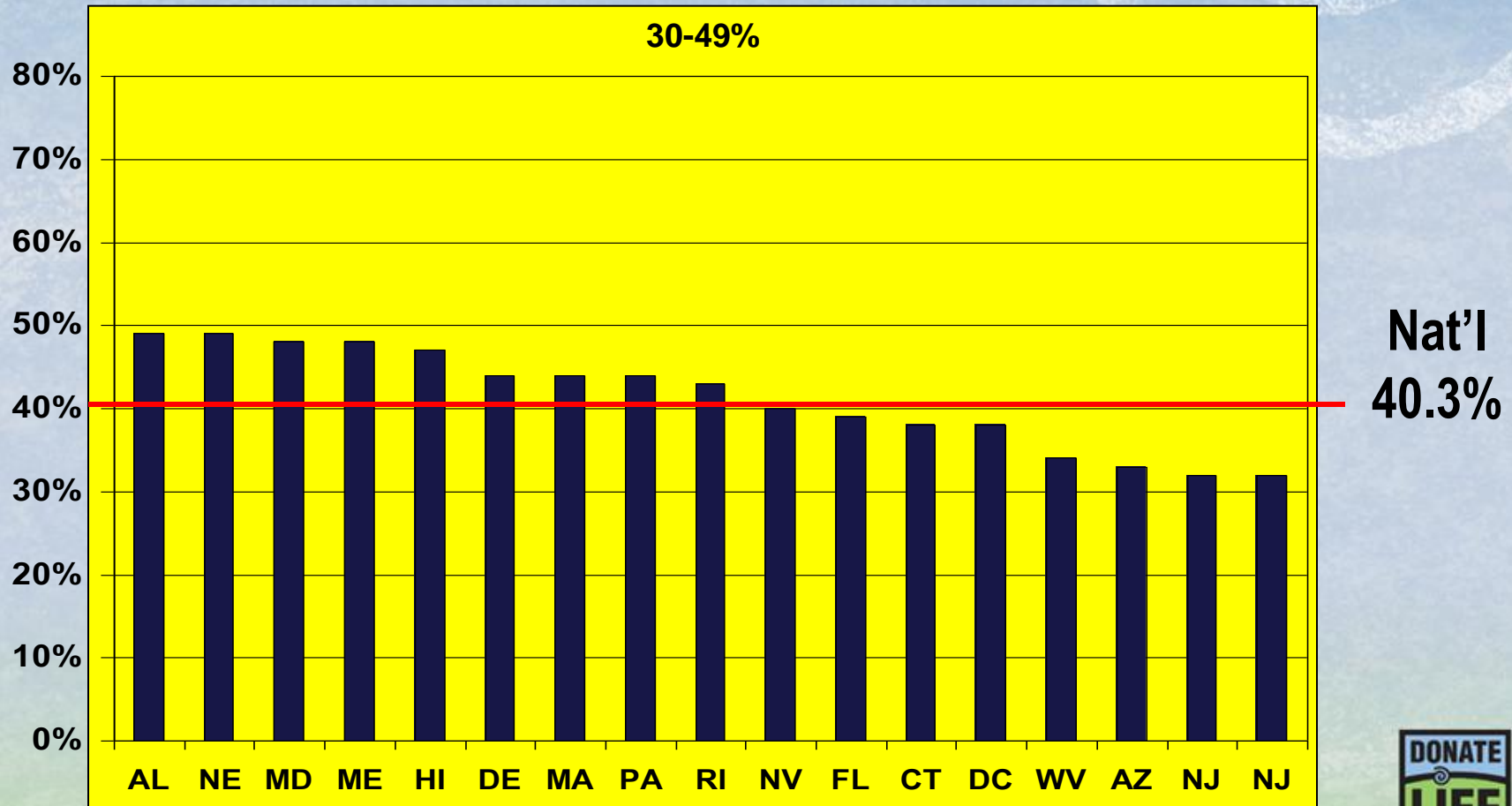
ADD Pop. 18+ Share, Q4 2010



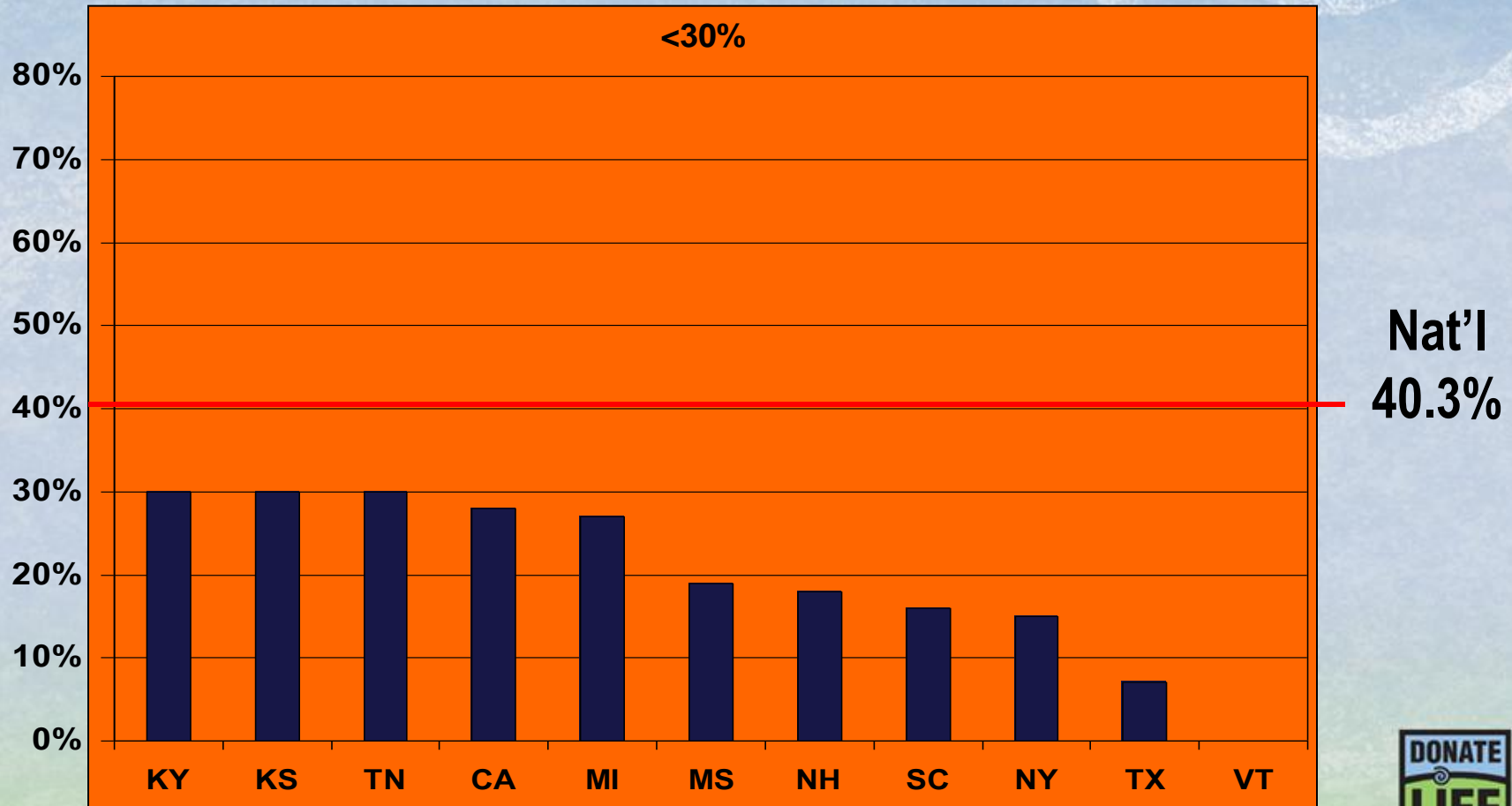

Signup Rate in Given Period of Time

Donor Designation Rate (DDR)

Rate at which individuals join the state donor registry expressed as a percentage of all drivers licenses and ID cards issued within a period of time

- **Example: If a state issues 200,000 driver's licenses in a quarter, and 80,000 of these drivers check 'yes' to be designated donors, the quarter's donor designation rate is 40%**

Summary: Donor Designation Rate, Q4 2010

- **32 states reported a cumulative donor designation rate of 38.7% (median 45.4%) for Q4 2010**
- **In 2010, donor designation rate increased in 18 of 24 states reporting**
- **Donor designation rate increased year over year in 14 of 24 states reporting**

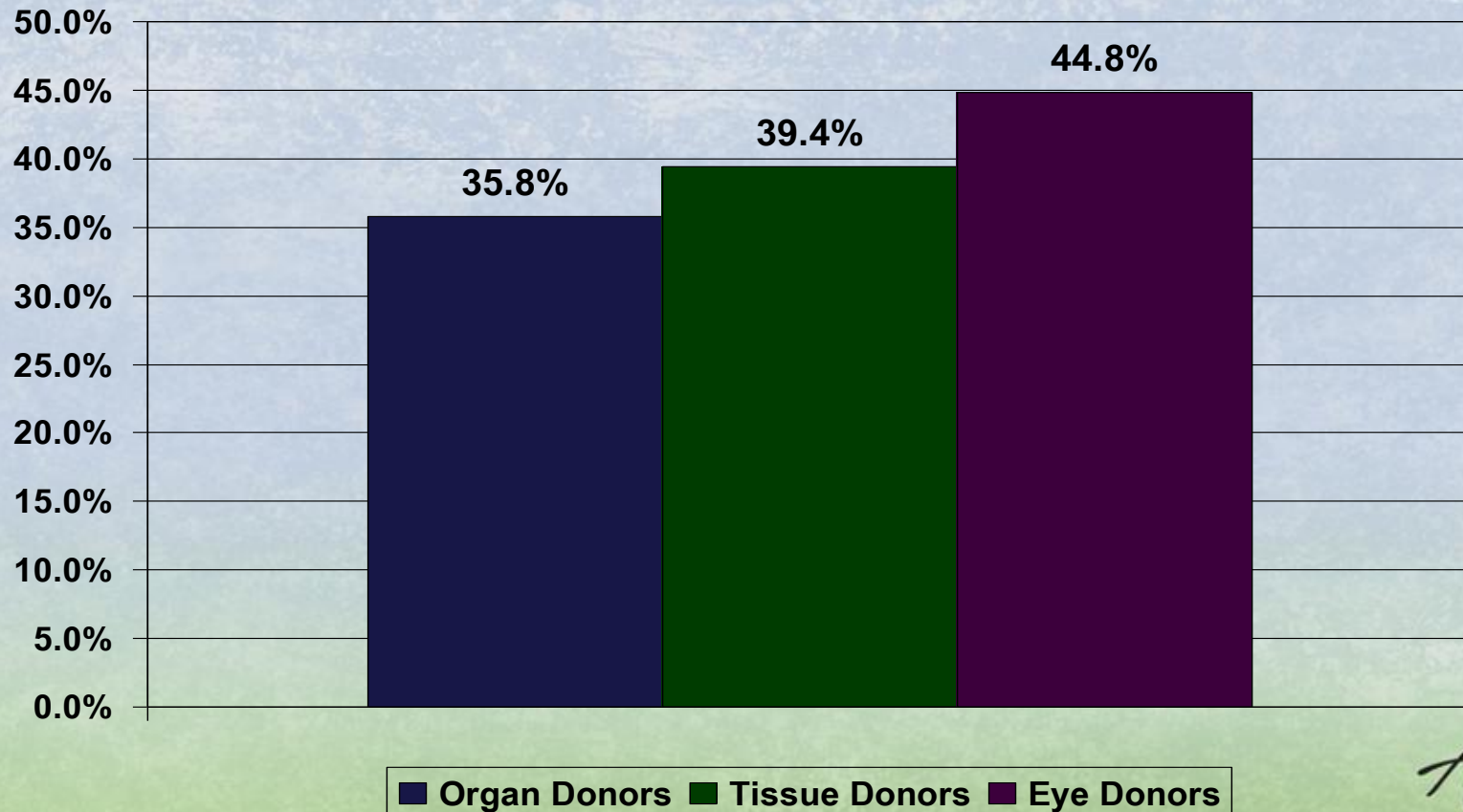
Summary: Impact on Donation, Q4 2010

- **Nationwide, 35.8% (33.2% in the last 12 months) of recovered organ donors were authorized by state donor registries**
- **Nationwide, 39.4% (37.3% in the last 12 months) of recovered tissue donors were authorized by state donor registries**
- **Nationwide, 45.2% (42.5% in the last 12 months) of recovered eye donors were authorized by state donor registries**



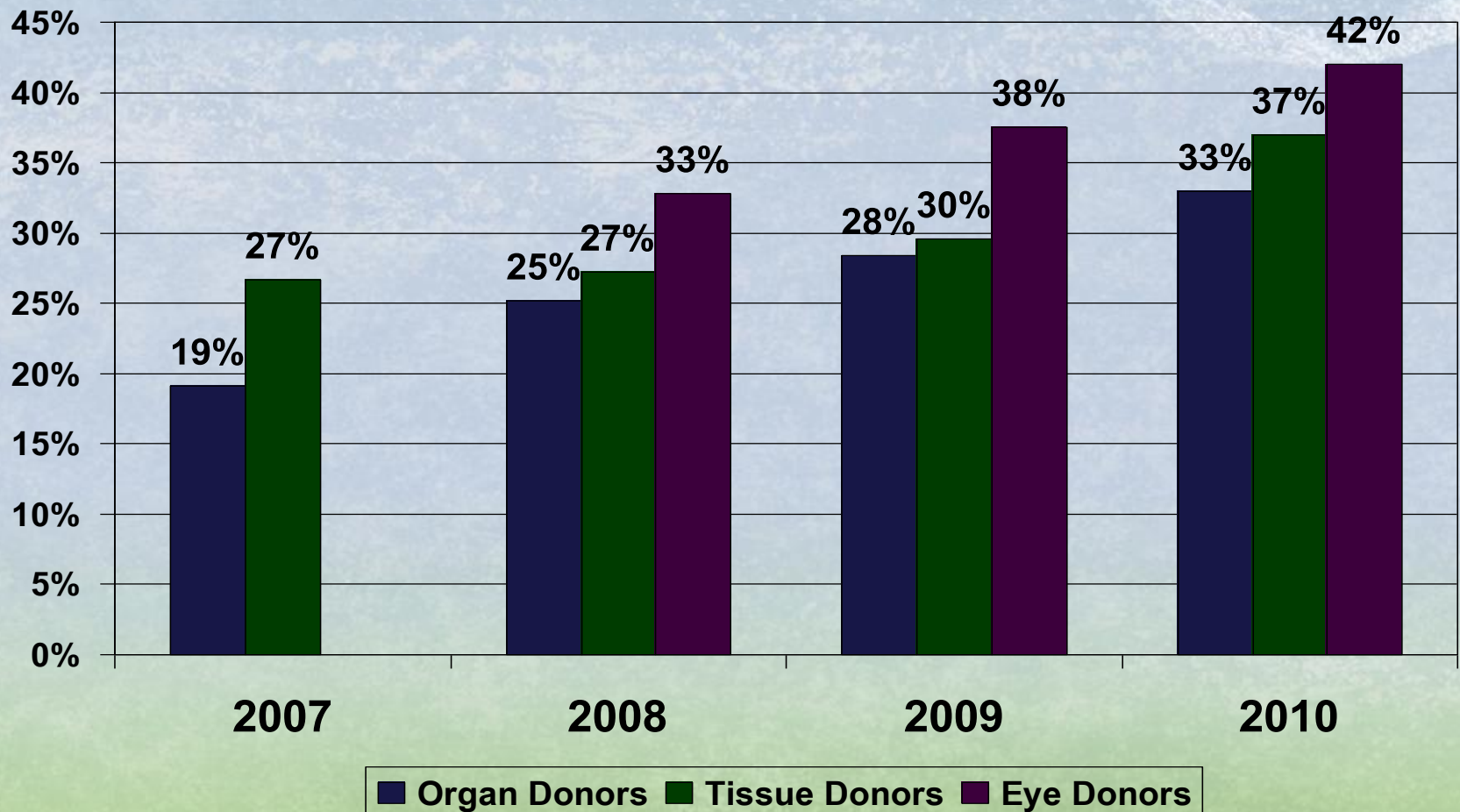
Impact on Donation, 12 Months Ending 9/30/10

Designated Donors Among Recovered Donors



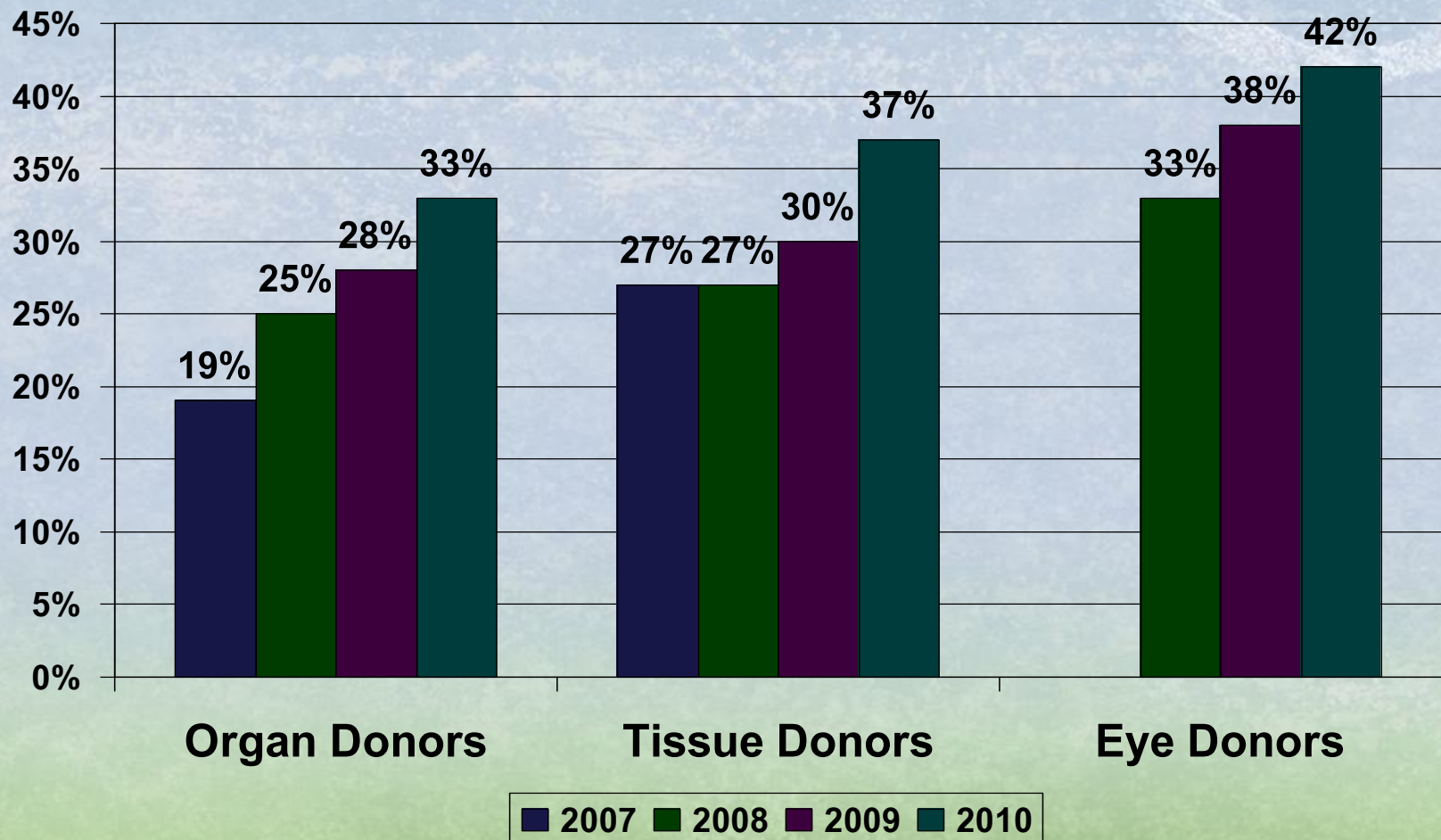
Impact on Donation, 2007-2010

Summary: Organ Donation, Q4 2010

- State donor registries authorized 35.8% of recovered organ donors in Q4 2010
- In Q4 2010, state donor registries authorized 50% or more of recovered organ donors in 18 states
- In Q4 2010, state donor registries authorized 40% or more of recovered organ donors in 30 states
